



From Philadelphia:

Via Broad Street: Travel North on Broad Street. Broad Street reaches a dead end at Cheltenham Ave. make a left onto Cheltenham Avenue. Follow signs for Route 309 North (right on to Ogontz Avenue). Take 309 North to the Norristown Road/ Springhouse Exit. Turn right onto Norristown Road. Travel down Norristown Road till the dead end, It will dead end into Horsham Road at a traffic light, make a left onto Horsham Road. Travel Horsham Road until you see a big brick sign on you left hand side that reads (Keith Valley Business Center) the next house immediately after that sign is 815 Horsham Road, it looks like a Residential home. Then proceed through the double French doors.

Via Route 76: Travel Route 76 East to Route 476 North, then follow instructions for the Pennsylvania Turnpike East.

From Pennsylvania Turnpike West or East:

From Pennsylvania Turnpike, take Exit 343 (Willow Grove). Follow signs for 611 North. Take 611 North past McDonalds, Donato's Etc. At Route 463/Horsham Road make a left (Wendy's on corner.) Travel down Horsham Road until you see a big brick sign on you left hand side that reads (Keith Valley Business Center) the next house immediately after that sign is 815 Horsham Road, it looks like a Residential home. Then proceed through the double French doors.

From Delaware or Philadelphia Airport Area:

Take I-95 to Route 476 North to the Pennsylvania Turnpike East then follow instructions for the Pennsylvania Turnpike East.

From South New Jersey:

Take the Ben Franklin or Walt Whitman Bridge and follow directions from Philadelphia.

From Doylestown:

Take 611 South to the Willow Grove Naval Air Station (on your right). When the fence ends for the Air Station, make a right at the traffic light (Maple Avenue). At 1st traffic light veer to your right onto Horsham Road. Travel down Horsham Road until you see a big brick sign on you left hand side that reads (Keith Valley Business Center) the next house immediately after that sign is 815 Horsham Road, it looks like a Residential home. Then proceed through the double French doors.
